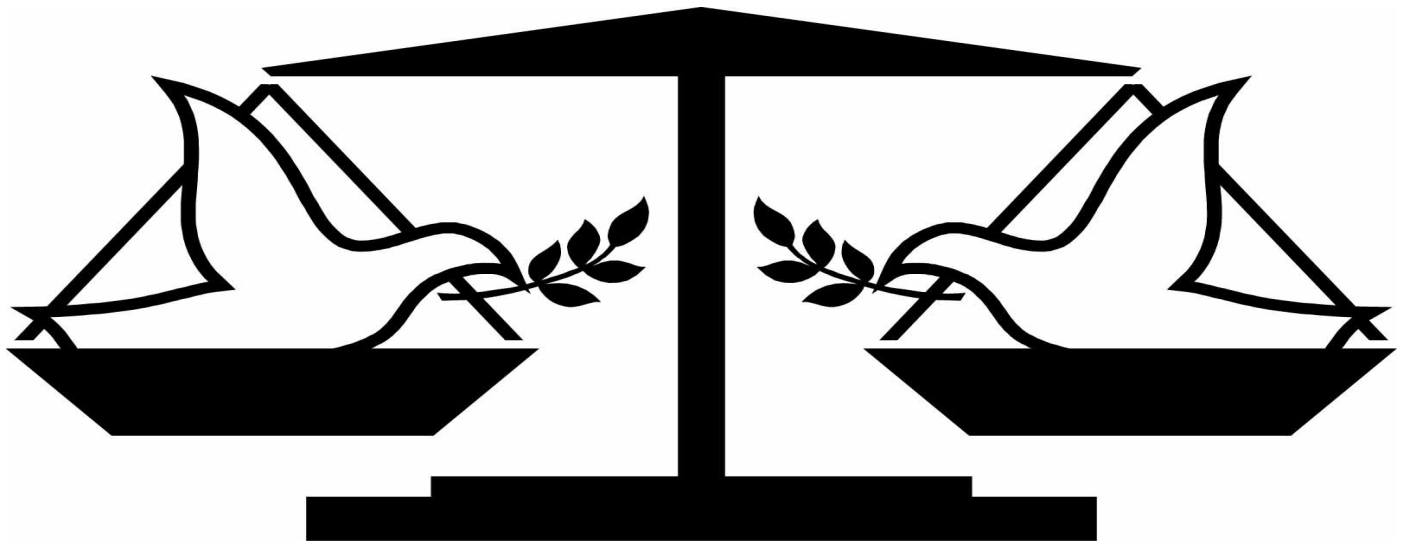


Peace Lutheran Church Justice Ministry Update - March 2019

NEHEMIAH ACTION Set for THURSDAY, APRIL 11 at the MLK, Jr. Performing Arts Center

We have made some progress with both the city and the county on affordable housing, but the commitments we received remain promises, not realities.
